Bishop Terrence E. Coleman was ordained as a Minister of the Gospel in 1988 under the Midwestern District of the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World, Inc. He is an anointed preacher, teacher and television/radio minister, pastoring the Greater Pentecostal Church of God since 1989. Bishop Coleman has served in the capacities of Foreign Missions Director an Assistant Treasurer, and currently as the Assistant General Treasurer of the Mid-western District of the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World.

Bishop Coleman graduated from the Gateway College of Evangelism with an Associate's Degree in Theology and has plans to continue theological studies by pursuing a Bachelor of Arts Degree.
